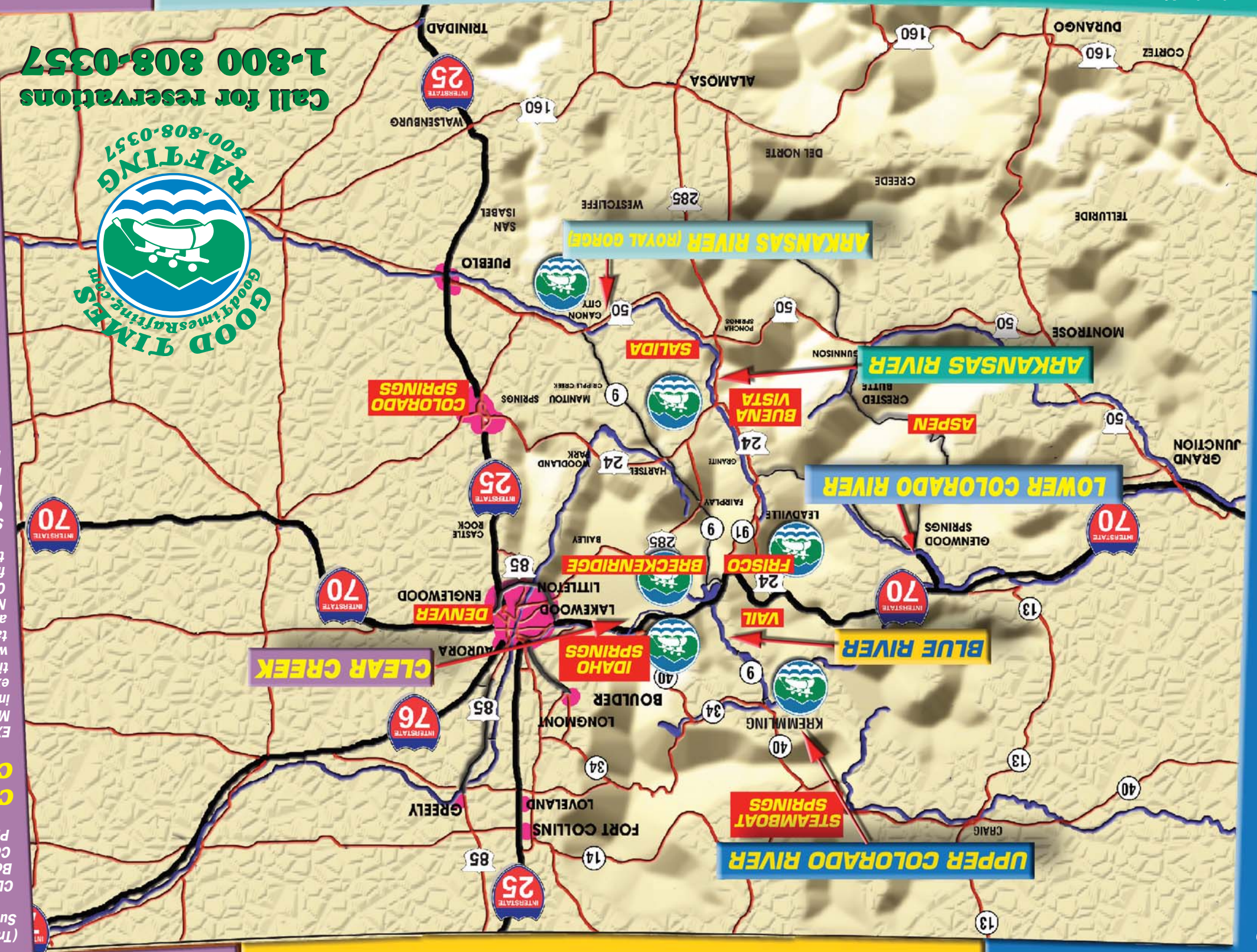

Don't forget your dry clothes and shoes. If you prefer, we also offer wetsuits, splash top and bootie rentals. **REMEMBER, THE WATER CAN BE COLD AND ALL TRIPS RUN RAIN OR SHINE!**

Expert Guides: Our friendly, knowledgeable staff can easily show you a truly memorable whitewater experience. Our guides are first aid and CPR certified, they are also trained above and beyond the state requirements for white water rescue and guiding.

Safety: Our number one concern is your safety. Before our river adventure begins, we give a thorough safety talk. This is not only a precautionary safety measure, but lets you in on some river insights from the guides' point of view.

Responsibility: River Rafting is an adventure sport involving a degree of risk on the part of the participant. Although we take precautions to ensure a safe and enjoyable trip, we cannot be responsible for lost or damaged articles or personal injury. We require that you acknowledge these risks by reading and signing a liability release prior to departure. Choose a trip within your personal limits.

Reservations/Deposits: Advance reservations are recommended, however we also cater to short notice phone reservations. A 50% deposit is required to guarantee space and can be made over the phone with any major credit card, by mail or by stopping by our office. Full payment is due prior to your trip. Raft trips require certain advance preparation. No refunds for cancellations will be made within 72 hours (2 weeks for groups) of scheduled trip.
